

# PRE-PATROL COMPLIANCE CHECKLIST

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Complete this checklist before beginning each fire watch patrol shift.  
Retain completed checklists on-site with patrol logs for AHJ inspection.

## 1. SYSTEM IMPAIRMENT VERIFICATION

- Identify the type of fire protection system impairment (sprinkler, alarm, standpipe)
- Confirm the scope and location of the impairment within the building
- Verify the expected duration of the impairment
- Review any work permits or maintenance orders related to the impairment

## 2. AHJ NOTIFICATION & DOCUMENTATION

- Confirm AHJ has been notified of the system impairment
- Record the AHJ notification date, time, method, and contact name
- Confirm insurance carrier has been notified (if required)
- Verify fire watch plan has been reviewed and approved by the AHJ (if required)

## 3. EQUIPMENT & SAFETY READINESS

- Verify fire extinguisher(s) are available, accessible, and fully charged
- Confirm communication equipment is operational (radio, phone)
- Check flashlight and spare batteries (for low-visibility areas)
- Verify PPE availability (hard hat, safety vest, as required)
- Confirm access to all areas included in the patrol route

## 4. PATROL ROUTE & PROCEDURES

- Review and confirm patrol route covers all impaired areas
- Verify maximum patrol interval (typically 60 minutes per NFPA 25)
- Confirm familiarity with fire alarm pull station and panel locations
- Review emergency exit locations and accessibility

## PRE-PATROL COMPLIANCE CHECKLIST (continued)

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- Verify evacuation procedures and assembly point locations

### 5. DOCUMENTATION READINESS

- Fire watch log sheets are available (printed or digital)
- Confirm log includes fields for: time, conditions, actions, initials
- Review previous shift log for any carry-over conditions or notes
- Verify incident reporting procedure and chain of command

### 6. PERSONNEL VERIFICATION

- Confirm fire watch personnel are trained and certified
- Verify personnel have valid identification on-site
- Review shift schedule and handoff procedures
- Confirm personnel are familiar with the specific site layout

### 7. EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

- Confirm knowledge of emergency contact numbers (fire dept, building manager)
- Review fire department access points and staging areas
- Verify location of nearest manual fire alarm pull stations
- Confirm knowledge of building fire alarm panel location and basic operation
- Review shelter-in-place vs. evacuation protocols for the building
